
## SUPPRESSOR SHIELD M-LOK® RAIL ATTACH COUPLER




(B) x 2 - Female Coupler Tab Screw

(C) x 2 - Allen keys (1/8", 3/32")


- (D) x 1 Male Coupler w/ Suppressor Shield
- (E) x 1 Female Coupler
- (F) x 1 Picatinny Rail Mounting Plate
- (G) x 2 Internal Rail Tab
- (H) x 1 Low-profile Mounting Plate





## WARNING: UNLOAD WEAPON & POINT IN SAFE DIRECTION

- \*Assemble dry (without thread locker) and finger tight initially.
- 1. Remove suppressor.
- 2. Separate female and male coupler (rotate opposite locking markings).
- 3. Assemble internal rail tabs to female coupler and slide assembly (tabs first) into muzzle end of forearm.



- 4. Hold female coupler assembly against forened, install external mounting plates through forward most M-LOK® slot, onto internal rail tabs.
- 5. Press female coupler firmly against end of forearm, tighten all 4 screws on mounting plates to approximately 25 inch-pounds.
- 6. Install suppressor.
- 7. Install Suppressor Shield.
  - a. Align top indexing lines of male coupler and female coupler.
  - b. Slide couplers together.
  - c. Rotate in direction of locking arrow until snug (90°). DO NOT over tighten.

<sup>\*</sup>Some larger muzzle brakes may require removal of 1 internal rail tab to install.

<sup>\*\*</sup>For a more secure/semi-permanent installation, remove one screw at a time and apply small amount of blue thread locker and re-tighten to 25 inch-pounds.
